Congratulations to all the children who received certificates and awards.

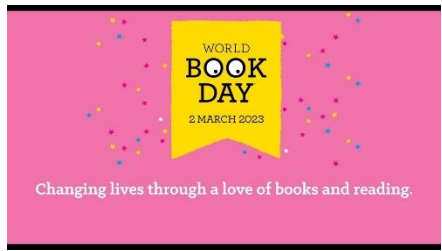

Visit from Mr Waterman – ‘Net Zero’ visit

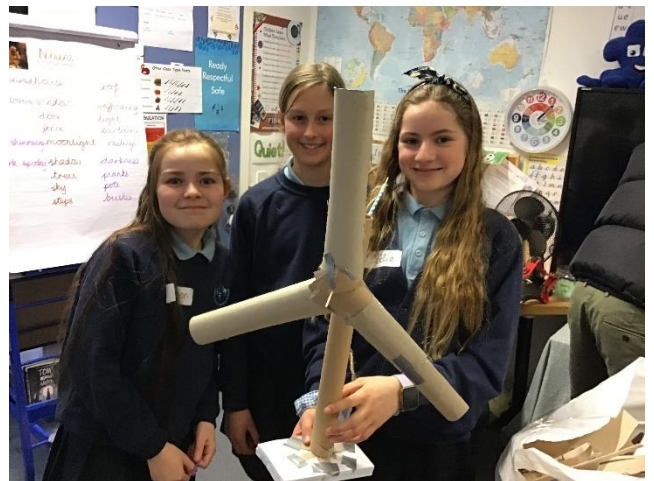
