

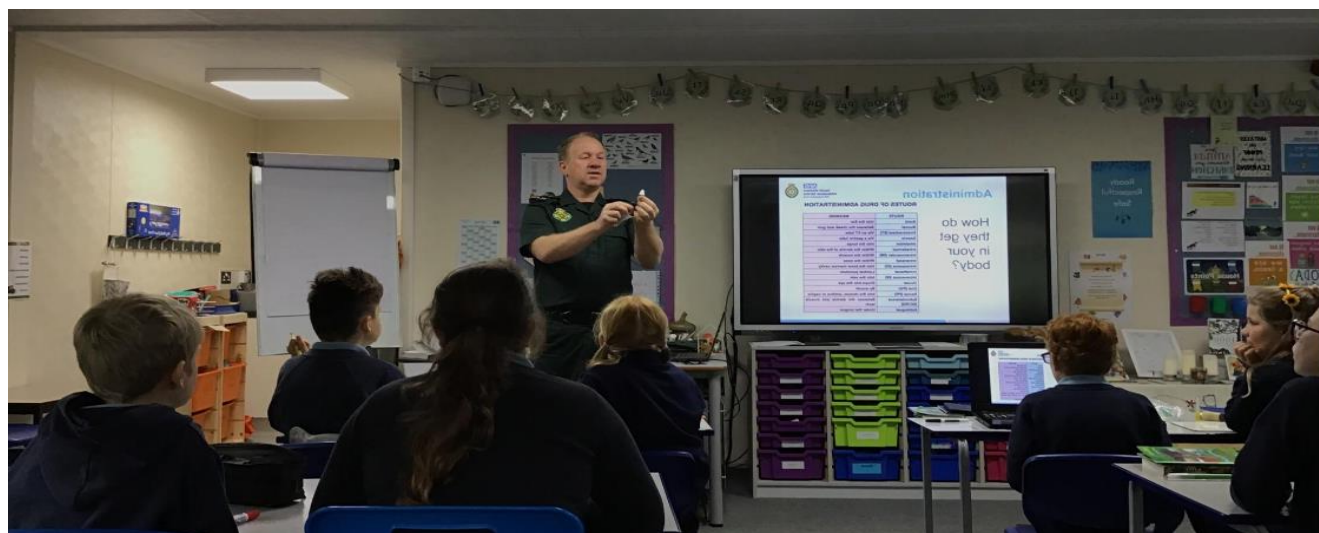
Ubley C of E Primary School Newsletter
