EAST HARP TREE FETE

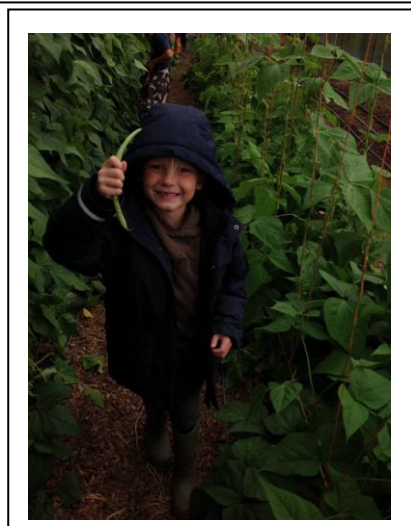
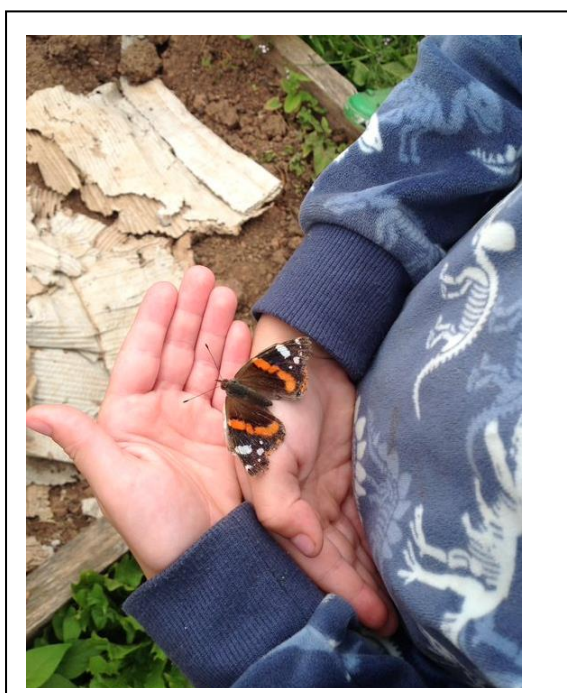
