Liz unfortunately unwell so couldn't attend – Lulu gave an update. At the beginning of the year the PTA bank account was standing at £8,219.35. Total income over the period was £3224.46. Total expenses were £3815.97. Balance as of 31st August 2021 was £7,627.84

Miriam asked if that amount is normal – Sara confirmed no that is not normal – we have discussed with Ian Harvey and now have a plan to spend most of the money (leaving just a small amount for travel etc)

4. UPDATE FROM IAN HARVEY

Very impressive that we managed to raise so much during covid times.

Really thoughtful events that actually raise good money. For example, the books from readathon – very successful, the impact will last a long time.

Would be good to have more parents involved with the PTA – will get hedgehog class teachers to push it.

Ideas for spending the money:

- Benches for the area at the bottom of the garden. Recycled plastic benches £1000 for 3.
- Sails moving away from this idea. Looking at canapes instead. Perhaps a wooden structure but this will make it more expensive. A large project to fundraise for.
- Workshops in science week in the spring.
- Music Drumming workshops both will complement the curriculum.
- Playground markings 2 quotes. High quality

Review of recent fundraising events:
