Just a reminder that if you are purchasing from Amazon then you can raise funds for the school. See attached flyer

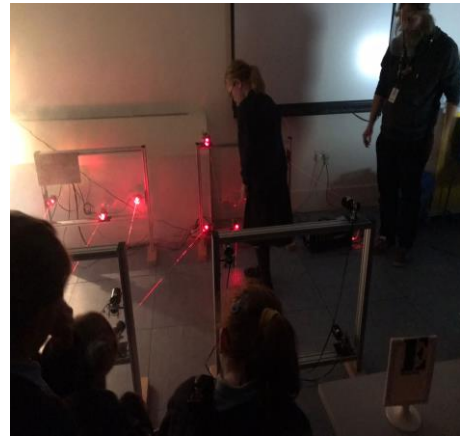
Whole School Pantomime
