## Good Luck Miss Careless

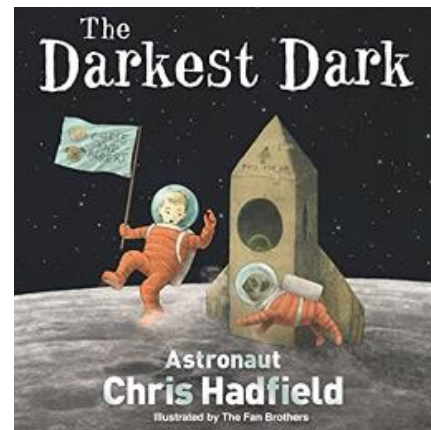
We all wish Miss Careless the very best of luck who starts maternity leave. She will be missed very much not only by Hedgehogs Class but the whole school.
