NHS advice for children with flu

Key Guidelines for Flu & School:

- **Fever is Key:** If your child has a high temperature (38°C/100.4°F+), they must stay home until it's gone.
- **Flu Symptoms:** Flu is more severe than a cold; if they're significantly unwell, tired, or have body aches, keep them home.
- **Prevent Spread:** Staying home protects classmates and teachers from catching the flu.
- **Return When Better:** They should return to school when fever-free for 24 hours (without fever-reducing medicine) and feeling up to it.
- **Hygiene:** Encourage frequent handwashing and tissue disposal to limit germ spread.
